## **Election of House Captains and Class Monitors**

This day was initiated by United Nations to highlight the various methods to prevent desertification. This year Santhome public school has initiated certain classroom activities as a part of social science day to inspire students and motivate them to come up with some innovative ideas to showcase love and

respect toward our mother earth. From 10th June to 17th June 2021, the week was planned. Social science teachers displayed the videos on desertification, environmental degradation, and droughts in their respective classes to make students aware about the environmental problems. On 17th June the pledge was taken in all the classes from grade VI to X by social science teachers and activities were conducted in all the classes.
